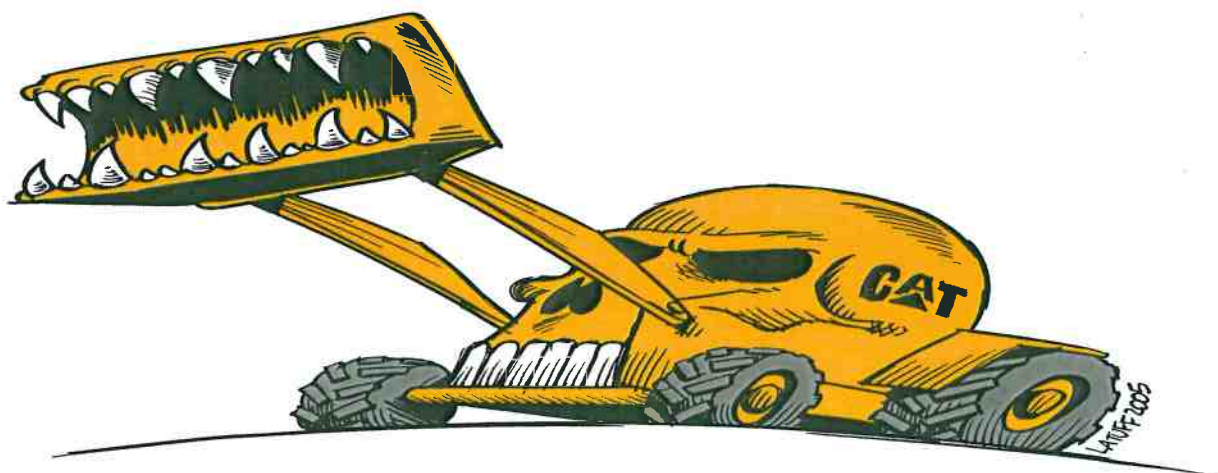

CEO's Report

The Shire has been steadily working on the renovation of the Heritage and Interpretative Centre (Old Wiluna Hospital) over the past twelve months. This stage of the project is due to reach practical completion by the end of June 2017. However minor renovation work will still be needed as the Shire also requires permission from the Heritage Council to install the lattice around the outside of the buildings, which is to improve safety and provide a higher level of access control.

The Arts Centre is expected to be reopened at the end of July 2017 when the facility manager commences her employment with the Shire. The main building is expected to be reopened to the public once the interpretation stage has been completed. At this time, the interpretation project is expected to take around six months to complete as the Shire is committed in delivering a high quality result.

Shire representatives will be attending the 2017 Developing Northern Australia Conference this month. Topics to be presented and discussed include land and water; food and agribusiness; forestry; resources and energy; tourism and hospitality; international education; healthcare and medical research; infrastructure; workforce opportunities; indigenous-led northern development; and developing strategic links as the Gateway to Asia.

It with a sad heart that I advise the community that Councillor Chris Webb has just resigned from Council after many years of dedicated service. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Chris for her dedicated service to the Wiluna community and wish her and her family all the best with their future endeavours.

**2017-18
OBJECTIVES AND REASONS FOR LEVYING DIFFERENTIAL
RATES**

At its Ordinary Meeting of Council held 31 May 2017, the Council of the Shire of Wiluna resolved the following objectives and reasons for levying differential rates and minimum payments:

1. The overall objective for differential rating is an attempt to ensure revenue is collected on an equitable basis, enabling the Shire to provide facilities, infrastructure and services to the entire community.
2. The Shire of Wiluna provides services to a diverse region consisting of Wiluna townsite, rural/pastoral, mining and exploration & prospecting. All sectors benefit from the services provided by the Shire, though it is inevitable that some sectors may benefit more from any particular service. Persons operating within all sectors have the right to use the services provided and the Shire does not seek to restrict the use of its services by any sector, though some will have a greater capacity to contribute to the Shire's revenue than others.
3. To levy an appropriate minimum rate that more closely reflects the costs of servicing lots within the townsite and the whole Shire area, and to ensure that a minimum contribution is made by all ratepayers for the benefit of the district.
4. As a means to maintain a balanced budget position with a reasonable contribution from all rating categories and a reasonable approach by the Council in regard to increases.
5. To correct over time a disparity between the UV rates applicable to mining and the UV rates applicable to exploration and prospecting.

Submissions from ratepayers and electors are invited in respect of the proposed rate or minimum payment and any related matters. Our dream is to teach our kids and other children the true value of the ocean and its impact on the environment. How to care for it and the animals that live in its beauty. 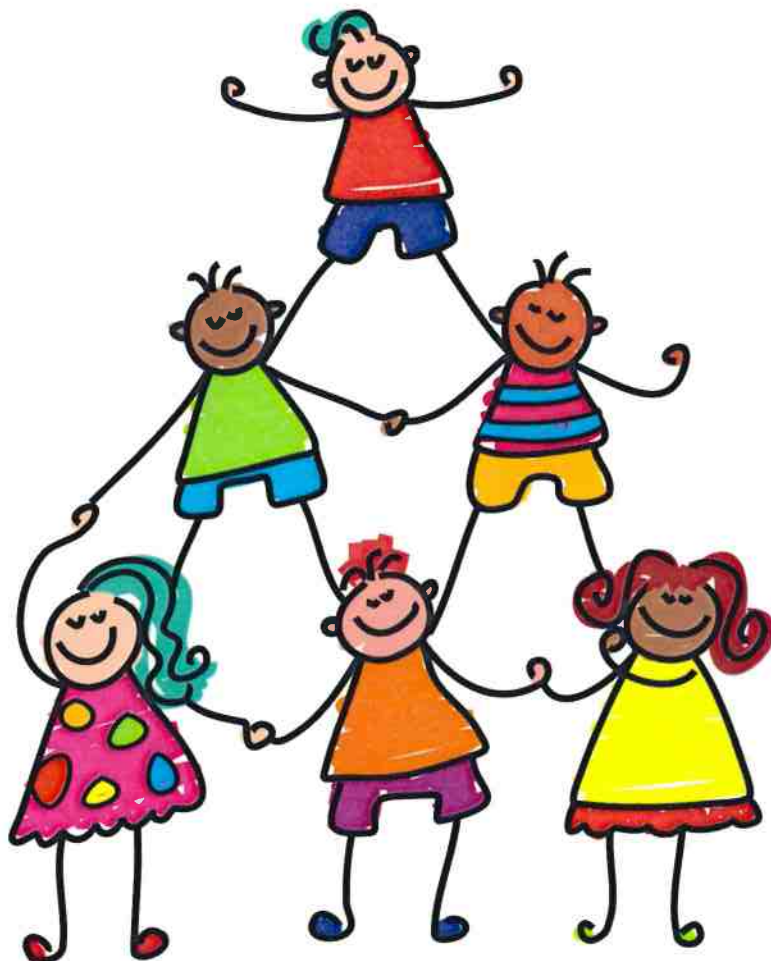

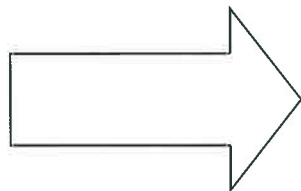




Sudoku
