Bus Service

The trial bus service running between Wiluna and Leonora has so far completed 6 return trips with only 3 passengers in total, with one of these passengers returning to Wiluna from Leonora and two passengers travelling from Leinster to Leonora where they met the Goldrush Tours bus for the trip to Kalgoorlie.

The results to date demonstrate that there is little demand for this bus service, and the Shire and the Public Transport Authority are currently reviewing this service.

Wiluna to Leonora Adult (one way) \$57, Concession (one way) \$35


Thursdays only: Kalgoorlie to Wiluna, Adult (one way) \$117

Tjukurba ART GALLERY

Louise Allerton, recently the Manager of Spinifex Arts Project (Tjuntjuntjarra) came to Wiluna at the end of October to conduct workshops and work with the Birriliburu Artists at the Tjukurba Art Gallery. Louise was impressed with the Gallery and the quality of the works being produced by our artists. While she was here she assisted with a bush trip to Ullula where the artists started work on a large collaborative painting by five of the Birriliburu Artists. Entitled The Seven Sisters, this beautiful painting tells the story of the constellation also known as the Pleiades. The constellation represents a group of young women who are pursued by a hunter from whom they ran and hid, moving across the country as he kept following them. They eventually escaped, flying upward to the sky where they can now be seen in the constellation.

The work was started at Ullula, the site of an old homestead, about 40kms from Wiluna and currently home to Don Miller who welcomed not only the five artists but also Louise Allerton and Siobhan Jenner (Art Gallery Assistant) and a number of ladies & staff from the Health and Aged Care Centre in Wiluna.

The five artists who completed the work were Beverly Wilson, Annette Williams, Wanita Morgan, Georgina (GB) Brown and Roxanne Anderson. It was a great opportunity for these skilled and talented women to come together in a place of great significance in order to re-tell the story of The Seven Sisters. You are welcome to come and see this remarkable work of art in the gallery.
